

Catholic Jeopardy

- 1) The Saint who, while Pope, resolved a conflict in the Corinthian Church while St. John the Apostle was living in Ephesus.
- 2) This Early Church Father & Saint lists all of the Popes who succeeded St. Peter up to his own time, 12 in all.
- 3) This Early Church Father, in the year AD 110, was the first to use the word “Catholic” in reference to Christ’s Church.
- 4) This Early Church Father addressed the holy Catholic Church and also prayed for it before being seated on an ass and being lead to his death in the city of Rome. He was martyred at the age of 86 because he refused to revile Christ.
- 5) This Early Church Father & Saint, who was a pupil of St. Polycarp, acknowledged that the presbyters in the Church have succession from the Apostles and warned that those outside the Apostolic succession are to be held in suspicion.
- 6) This Early Church Father & Bishop, who died in the year 268, rejected the notion that the remission of sins could be given outside the Church.
- 7) This Early Church Father, who died in the year 240, addresses the difference between the terms “Infallible” and “Impeccable” by calling Peter’s mistake one of procedure and not of doctrine.
- 8) This Early Church Father wrote about Apostolic succession and obedience to the presbyters in a letter chastising the Corinthian Church.
- 9) This Early Church Father and lawyer proclaims that while many churches were founded in many different cities, they all had as their source the one Apostolic church, and maintained one faith, & one doctrine.
- 10) This Early Church Father & Saint confirmed one of the Four Marks of the Church by saying “that there is One God, One Christ, One Church, and One Chair founded on Peter by the word of the Lord.”
